EXPERIENCE

Arthur has over fifty years of communications experience, dating back to 1955 when he began his career as a USAF civilian at Robins AFB. Over the next five decades Arthur has dedicated himself to mastering his craft and has become one of the most respected communications experts in his field.

Arthur has performed field engineering surveys at USAF installations in Alaska, California, and Florida, to name a few, and at Tinker AFB he was selected to establish an engineering and installation program that allowed small projects to be engineered and installed by on-site personnel with minimal assistance from the EID. That program reduced the entire project length by half, and increased the quarterly production rate over 200%.

After 32 years of civil service he retired at Tinker AFB and returned home to Florida in 1988. In October of that same year he started another career with a USAF contractor, still within the communications engineering field. He designed and produced engineering plans for communications cabling to service missile support systems, local area networks, T-1 carrier system, and wideband data circuits. He received cash awards for saving the USAF 1.4 million dollars and was also nominated for the Computer Sciences Corporation (CSC) award for technical excellence---the highest technical recognition given by CSC.

In 1997 Arthur began working for another USAF contractor supporting the 45th Space Wing Geographic Information Management System (GIMS). He performed quality control inspections during the initial conversion of the Communications System Installation Records (CSIR) from hard copy drawings into a fully digital enterprise GIS application. He is currently providing quality control for Spatial Technologies' outside cable plant projects that are implementing the Communication Visualization Component (CVC) software application.
